

INVITATION

ABOUT HOST INSTITUTE



Guru Angad Dev Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (GADVASU), Ludhiana was established in 2006 to serve the society by promoting livestock production, health and prevention of diseases through integrated teaching, research and extension programmes. There are six constituent colleges viz. College of Veterinary Science (Ludhiana and Rampura Phul Campus), College of Dairy Science and Technology, College of Fisheries, College of Animal Biotechnology and Veterinary Polytechnic College, Kaljharani along with three Regional Livestock Research & Training Centers and three Krishi Vigyan Kendras. The university has two affiliated colleges (Khalsa College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Amritsar and Baba Hira Das Ji College of Veterinary Pharmacy, Badal,

Sri Muktsar Sahib). The Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) has accredited university with 'A' grade and ranked First among the Indian State Veterinary Universities and Seventh amongst Agricultural Universities in 2019-20. GADVASU has established viral testing laboratory for testing COVID-19 and made significant contribution to the 'Mission Fatch' of the Govt. of Punjab. Under its One Health Program GADVASU has so far conducted more than 5.5 lakh Covid test for making the community safe. GADVASU has state-of-the-art diagnostic and treatment facilities in its Multi Speciality Veterinary Hospital (MSVH). With an annual OPD of nearly 32000 farm and pet animals, MSVH caters the need of animal owners from all over North India. GADVASU also have DBT-Canine research centre and working in various areas like Canine Nutrition, Vaccine Delivery System, Diagnosis and Bio markers for various diseases etc.; Department of Animal Nutrition is concentrating its efforts on improving the low cost technologies for farmer's use. Department is regularly manufacturing Area Specific Mineral mixtures (for different climatic zones of Punjab), Mineral Mixtures for high yielding animals, Fortified Bypass Fat and Uromin Lick; supplying at nominal rates to the farmers. GADVASU is the 1st in India to promote Pig Specific Mineral Mixture. The Fish Specific Mineral Mixture is also being launched shortly.

ABOUT THE CITY

Ludhiana is the largest Industrial city of Punjab and was established by the Emperor Lodhi in 1481. It is also known as "Manchester of India". City is well known for small scale industries, hosiery goods, bicycles, auto parts, & textiles.



WEATHER AND ACCOMMODATION

The weather in Ludhiana is generally pleasant in November (Day temperature 26-28°C, Night temperature 15-18°C). Participants may bring light woolen garments. Limited accommodation (on payment basis) is available in Guest Houses (for faculty) and Farmer's Hostels (for students) at GADVASU and PAU, Ludhiana on first come first serve basis (subject to prior registration along with fee). Numbers of good hotels (4 and 5 star category) are also available near the GADVASU campus (Nagpal Regency, Radisson Blu, Hyatt Regency etc.)

TRANSPORT

The city is located approximately 100 km from Chandigarh, nearest airport is Shaheed-E-Azam Bhagat Singh, Chandigarh and 320 km from New Delhi which is well connected with superfast trains like Shatabadi, Rajdhani & Vande Bharat. Distance from Ludhiana Railway station (station code:LDH) & Bus stand to University campus is about 5 km which can be easily covered by frequent taxi or auto rickshaw services.

VENUE

The venue of the conference will be Nirvana Hotel, (www.nirvana.co.com) Hambran Road 4 km from the University. It may contain maximum two tables and one figure.
